Job title: Health and Safety Advisor	
Main purpose of job: The Health and Safety Advisor will provide expert guidance and practical support to ensure ABBA Voyage operates safely, responsibly, and in line with current legislation and best practice at the ABBA Arena. The role will advise managers and teams on health and safety matters, conduct risk assessments, and support the implementation of safe systems of work. By coordinating incident reporting, delivering training, and carrying out inspections and audits, the postholder will help embed a positive safety culture across all areas of the Arena. Acting as a trusted advisor, the Health and Safety Advisor will work collaboratively with varied stakeholders including colleagues, partners and contractors to ensure risks are well managed and that the organisation remains compliant, resilient, and prepared for future challenges.

KEY ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Role Responsibilities:

- Assist in the implementation, monitoring, and continuous improvement of our health and safety management processes and systems, ensuring alignment with current legislation and best practice.
- Draft and review operational and risk documentation, supporting key stakeholders and risk owners to ensure suitable implementation of risk mitigation actions.
- Support managers and teams in conducting and reviewing risk assessments and developing safe systems of work.
- Maintain accurate records, documentation, and reporting for audits and inspections.
- Provide practical advice on risk and hazard identification and proportionate control measures.
- Assist with investigations by collating evidence, maintaining records, and supporting the identification of corrective actions.
- Deliver and coordinate health and safety training, toolbox talks, and awareness campaigns.
- Monitor completion of mandatory training and provide updates to department heads and senior leadership.
- Carry out regular site inspections and compliance checks, highlighting areas for improvement and ensuring remedial actions are tracked.



- Work collaboratively with managers, employees, and contractors to build a positive and proactive safety culture.
- Chair monthly venue Health & Safety committee meetings and collate reports.
